The parish council would be wasting money and given the current financial difficulties that the country is facing, and the vast numbers of residents not wishing to change the situation, members decided not to pursue this matter any further.

The clerk said they would have first drafts of the budget for 2023/2024 by the end of the month. A precept meeting date was agreed for 6pm on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

### **8816 TENNIS COURTS**

The clerk informed members that the tennis coaching staff had asked if they could install a portable toilet for the staff to use. They would pay for the toilet, clean it themselves and keep it locked. Members agreed assuming there were no complaints from residents.

Mr McDonald attended a meeting with the developers of the Lilliebrook site located on the Cox Green side of Woodlands Park Avenue. He had got agreement from the developers that there would only be emergency exit onto the avenue.

Mr Ford attended the Airfield Consultative Meeting and gave feedback that were listening to complaints and acknowledging how noisy the planes can be. They have concerns that when the dwellings are built on Grove park, new residents will complain about the noise. The airfield have a firework display on the 29<sup>th</sup> October.
